

The Board of Trustees met in special session on January 7, 2020 at 5:30 pm in the high school library for the purpose of considering a paraprofessional, DCC agreement & superintendent /principal evaluation.

Trustees present: Bryce Hove, Sara Moline, Cary Phillips, Krista Beery, Dusty White & Tyrel Massar. Also in attendance were Clerk Della Van Horn, Superintendent Wenz, Principal Megan Murrell, Sandy Schillinger, Kim Gebhardt & Amy McCloy.

Moved by White, seconded by Moline to offer Megan Volbrecht a paraprofessional position for the remaining of the 2019-20 year at \$11.00 per hour. Discussion was held on posting the nepotism ad. Moved by White, seconded by Hove to table a decision on the paraprofessional position until the nepotism ad can be posted. Motion carried unanimously by the combined board.

Mr. Wenz reported that the Dawson Community College agreement to hold adult ed classes has not been finalized. Moved by Moline, seconded by Massar to table any decision on the DCC agreement. Motion carried unanimously by the combined board.

Rating: exceeds & meets expectations (1 does not meet expectations)
6. Oversees financial management
Rating: meets expectations & does not meet expectations
7. Oversees facilities management
Rating: meets expectations & exceeds expectations
