Dear future Kindergartner and Family,

I'd like to welcome you to a new and exciting year of school! Your first day of school will be **Monday, August 19th**. Parents, you are invited to bring your child to class on the first day of school for a mini open house. From 8 a.m. - 9 a.m., we will have an opportunity to get to know and explore our classroom together with a couple of fun games and activities. Students will stay in school all day on their first day. School starts at 7:55 a.m. and dismissal is at 3:35 for grades K-3 and 3:41 for grades 4-12. The buses run after the later dismissal time. Here is a list of the school supplies that you will need to bring the first day of class:

- 2 boxes of color crayons (24 pack works the best...please no bigger)
- 1 two-pocket folder
- 1- 1 inch binder WITH POCKETS
- 1- 1/2 inch binder WITH POCKETS
- Pack of 12 plain pencils (this will be shared with the whole class; no name needed on this)
- A supply box to hold markers, crayons, scissors etc. (no zipper boxes)
- A beach towel (no sleeping bags, mats, or pillows please) to rest
- 4oz bottle of Elmer's glue
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors
- A box of Crayola markers 10 count, washable is preferred (not skinny markers)
- A pair of clean P.E. shoes that will be left at school-*If your child has difficulty tying shoes, please send velcro shoes.*
- A backpack (please make sure a binder can fit in it)
- A water bottle that can be left at school to be refilled
- 1 change of clothes that will be kept at school (include socks, shirt, pants, and undies). Please store clothes in a large ziplock bag.
- Box of crackers or pretzels for snack time; please NO cookies or chips (this will be shared with the whole class; no name needed on this)

Please be sure to label everything (unless stated differently above). Many times, articles are similar, such as lunch boxes, boots, coats, hats, mittens, and they sometimes get mixed up. From time to time during the year, I may be sending notes home with the students asking for items that we might need for various projects.
